Qualifying Requirements

Purpose: to recognize a Rotarian in District 6970 who has demonstrated a lifetime of *service above self* to the community and the world.

Criteria

- 1. An individual who has a long history of exemplary business professionalism, ethics, humility, and integrity. One who has been a Rotarian for at least 10 years, consistently supporting club service projects and other club activities as well as Rotary International's goals.
- 2. An individual who is involved in community service, applying their time and talents in steady, long-term commitments that exemplify the spirit of Rotarian Service-Above-Self.
- 3. An individual who is a generous supporter of The Rotary Foundation, the Club programs and other charitable endeavors.
- 4. An individual who is making a difference in the lives of many in the local community and the world.

This award is made at the sole discretion of the standing District Governor. Nominating guidance and other information is being developed and reviewed by the District Awards Committee and Governor Corps.
