GUIDELINES FOR DRIVE-UP OR WALK-UP COMMODITY DISTRIBUTION BY GROUPS AND ORGANIZATIONS



Pre-Event	
	Ensure a safe work environment for all personnel and participants involved in the event.
	Ensure personal protective equipment (PPE) is available for all event personnel and that appropriate training for intended PPE use is provided in advance of the event.
	Ensure enough hand sanitizer or other hand cleaning options are provided.
	Each flat surface and tables should have hand sanitizer or hand cleaning options.
	Ensure all surfaces are cleaned with an approved disinfectant prior to the beginning of the event and remain clean throughout the event. Collection and disposal of bio-hazardous waste should be coordinated prior to the event.
	 Ensure service line is clearly defined utilizing tape, cones, or other distancing markers Cones or markers should be spaced at least 6 feet distance in all directions Participants should demonstrate social distancing by standing next to an assigned cone or marker
	For COVID-19 testing, required paperwork will be available and completed in accordance with HHS and Florida Health Department requirements.
	Vehicular traffic patterns for participant ingress and egress shall be coordinated with the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office or appropriate law enforcement agency.
Event	
	Identify an official event safety coordinator to ensure a safe environment for all participants.
	Participants should approach each section of the event only when advised by event personnel.
	Event personnel that are required to be in close proximity within 6 or more feet of participants should wear a gown, gloves, eye protection, and N95 mask.
	Event personnel, who are not in close proximity with participants, should wear gloves and a surgical style mask.
	Event participants not in a vehicle should wear a surgical style mask.
	Event personnel should change gloves between each event participant encounter where cross-contamination is possible.
	For testing sites or medically related events, an onsite Advanced Life Support transport unit is recommended.
	Participants should enter the established line through a pre-designated entrance point, clearly identified with cones or markers and appropriate signage.
Post-Event	
	Ensure all surfaces and items should be cleaned, consistent with Center for Disease Control recommended disinfectant procedures and all used PPE is disposed of appropriately in bio-hazardous waste.
