

### 2020-21 District Grants:

This Rotary year the SHARE Committee, which is comprised of our District Governor, Governor-Elect, Governor Nominee, District Grants Chair, District Foundation Chair and Rotarians from the top 3 per capita giving clubs and the top 2 highest giving clubs from the previous year awarded 26 grants totaling over \$137,000 to Do Good in our communities and the world. **As a reminder, April 1st is the deadline to submit your final report** along with required documentation and 3 accompanying photos on DACdb. However, if you have already completed the projects, please submit ASAP as we have a couple of worthwhile projects that we may be able to fund with unused monies.

### 2021-2022 District Grant Cycle:

If you are considering applying for a District Grant for the next Rotary year, the **deadline for application on DACdb is April 30, 2021**. Please be sure that you change the Org Year in the upper right corner to 2021-22. As a reminder these projects should be "shovel ready" and must be able to be completed from the time we receive Rotary Foundation approval (approx. mid-August) thru April 1, 2022. The grant must fall within one of Rotary's Seven Areas of Focus, which includes the newest focus on the Environment. Please also note that the District Grant team is planning an on-line District Grant Project Fair to be held in mid-March. This project fair is an opportunity to showcase and seek support and partners for a project that you are planning OR for your club to find a worthwhile project that you would like to support. More details to follow.
